1 PARENT COUNCIL

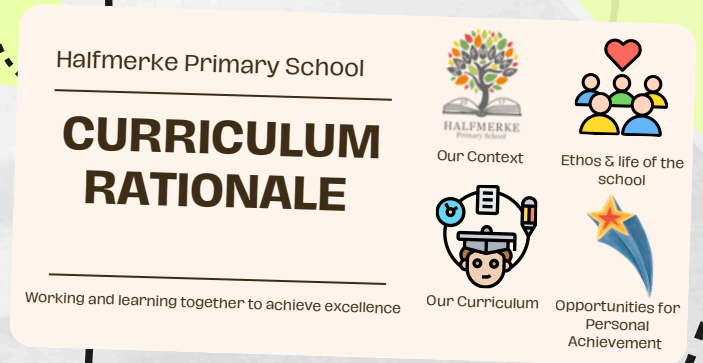
Thank you to all our families for their contributions to our Christmas Fayre. We are looking forward to seeing many of you come along on the night!
